



RADYR LAWN TENNIS CLUB PLAYING REGULATIONS

1. The laws as adopted by the Lawn Tennis Association shall be the laws of the Club as regards play unless inconsistent with any Rules or Regulations of the Club.
2. No one shall be allowed to play on the courts unless wearing non-marking, smooth soled tennis shoes and recognised tennis clothing.
3. Shoe tags must be worn by all playing Members.
4. The Chairman, Captains, Team Captains or Groundsman, or in their absence, any member of the Management Committee shall have power to prohibit play on all or any of the courts when they think it necessary and to reserve any courts for league matches, tournaments, coaching or any other purpose. The order of priority of matches is league, tournament, social.
5. On Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays and after 6.00 pm on other days apart from Mondays, senior Members shall have first claim to courts and choice of courts. At other times no seniors may play more than one short set (i.e. a tiebreak at 5-5) if a junior set of four is waiting to play.
6. On the following evenings after 6.00pm the categories listed shall have first claim to the courts:
 - Monday - Juniors
 - Tuesday - Ladies
 - Thursday - MenSubject to regulation 5 if Members are waiting to play, any social match in progress shall be limited to one short set, after which the waiting Members shall be included in the next match, according to their priority.
7. No Members, senior or junior, shall be entitled to commence playing singles when other Members of their category are waiting to play, but a game of singles, having been already commenced, may be concluded as a short set.
8. No play shall be permitted on any courts after 10.00 pm, the floodlights will switch off automatically at this time.
9. Members may introduce guests who may play on three occasions during any one year commencing 1st April. Guests shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Club and must be accompanied by a Member at all times. A Member introducing a guest shall be personally responsible for ensuring payment of Visitors' Fees.
10. Court gates must be closed on leaving a court.
11. Consideration should be shown to other Members at all times, particularly when passing a court where play is in progress. The use of bad language, throwing of rackets, hitting of nets, etc. is not permitted.
